Privacy Policy

Thank you for visiting the Eugene Folklore Society web site. The Eugene Folklore Society is committed to safeguarding the personal information entrusted to us by customers. This notice addresses privacy concerns about the information collected on this site. This policy is effective on and after 5/18/2021, and may be modified from time to time by the Eugene Folklore Society. It is a modification of the former policy dated 12/1/2015.

What personal data we collect

We collect the data that you provide us when you fill out any of the forms provided on the site. We do not sell your information or use it for purposes other than transacting EFS business. We also have data from our former web site which was gathered under the 12/1/2015 privacy policy.

We do not hold your credit card number. The card number is directly entered into the Stripe payment processing software. PayPal is also available for use.

The software that runs our site may collect technical data for use in communicating with your. We are unaware of what it collects or whether it uses any cookies, and do not directly use or store any personal data from that software.

Cookies

We may use cookies for the enhanced operation of the web site. We do not make any additional use of the cookies. The underlying software may also use cookies to generate statistics about the web site. We see only statistical data with no personally identifiable information from the use of these cookies.

How do we use personal information?

We use your information to verify your membership status, to communicate with you regarding upcoming events, to communicate with you regarding events and administrative tasks. When you volunteer to help at EFS events we use your information to contact you regarding volunteer services. When you make a donation some of your information is utilized in our tax reporting. In some cases we are working with a 3rd party for carrying out our activities, and they may require some personal information to carry out their services.

Certain activities may create a roster listing the names and contact information of the participants, and distribute the roster to the participants. For those events we ask for your permission as to what information you wish to appear on the roster.

What rights you have over your data

You may request to receive the stored information, and may request that it be edited or deleted. We may need to retain some data for administrative or legal purposes.

Where we send your data

We don't. Your data might be used on other EFS software.

How we protect your data

Our site is built on DreamHost systems using WordPress softwhere which have a variety of data protection and intrusion protection features.

We have volunteers carrying out all actions in our organization. It is possible that they have some of your data, typically contact data, to carry out their required tasks, and that data may not be held on a fully-secure computer system.

Personal data we receive from third parties

We receive transactional data from PayPal and Stripe which contains personal data regarding your (un-)successful payment.

What automated decision making and/or profiling we do with user data

Our bulk mailing makes decisions based on personal data, such as whether your membership has been paid for the upcoming year and whether you choose to receive. Your profile is based on the information provided on the various forms, and not generated profiling.
